## **Duties and Powers of the Standing Committees and the Ad Hoc Committees of the Senate Under the Rules of Procedure of the Senate B.E. 2562 (2019)**

The Senate has the power to establish committees to perform duties and powers to consider bills, carry out activities, undertake fact-finding or study any matter under the duties and powers of the Senate or as entrusted by the Senate and report the result to the Senate. According to the Rules of Procedure of the Senate B.E. 2562 (2019), the Senate has established 26 Standing Committees, two Ad Hoc Committees and the Committee on Monitoring, Recommending and Accelerating National Reform and the Preparation and Implementation of the National Strategy having duties and powers as follows:

### **The Standing Committees**

#### **(1) The Committee on Poverty and Inequality Reduction**

shall have the duties and powers to consider bills, carry out activities, undertake fact-finding or study any matter concerning the improvement in opportunity, right, ability, accessibility to resources, equality, participatory growth, accessibility to welfare and services of people and community in order to reduce the poverty and inequality in society, including follow up the systematic and continued implementation of the Sufficiency Economy Philosophy to attain the sustainable development goals which focus on people centered development, as well as study, monitor, recommend and accelerate National Reform and Master Plans of the National Strategy under the duties and powers and other relevant matters.

## **(2) The Committee on Sports**

shall have the duties and powers to consider bills, carry out activities, undertake fact-finding or study any matter concerning encouragement, promotion, and development of national sports and higher vocational education on sports, strengthen sport potentiality and body of knowledge in sport sciences to create a value in development of people, society and country, study the problems and obstacles of national and international sports development, as well as study, monitor, recommend and accelerate National Reform and Master Plans of the National Strategy under the duties and powers and other relevant matters.

shall have the duties and powers to consider bills, carry out activities, undertake fact-finding or study any matter concerning encouragement, promotion, problem solving and development of agriculture, utilization of land, water and factors of agricultural production, development of agricultural human resources, agricultural industry, food and co-operatives, development of production, transformation, agribusiness and value-added agriculture, as well as study, monitor, recommend

and accelerate National Reform and Master Plans of the National Strategy under the duties and powers and other relevant matters.

shall have the duties and powers to consider bills, carry out activities, undertake fact-finding or study any matter concerning transportations, including land, water and air transportations, mass transportation, freight transportation, merchant marine, infrastructure connecting Thai transportations to the World, as well as study, monitor, recommend and accelerate National Reform and Master Plans of the National Strategy under the duties and powers and other relevant matters.

#### **(5) The Committee on Economics, Monetary and Finance**

shall have the duties and powers to consider bills, carry out activities, undertake fact-finding or study any matter concerning overview economy, national and international economic situations which may impact Thai economy, including policies and national economic development plans, monetary matters, finance, banking, insurance, capital and bond markets, increment of national competitiveness and state enterprise policies, as well as study, monitor, recommend and accelerate

National Reform and Master Plans of the National Strategy under the duties and powers and other relevant matters.

**(6) The Committee on Foreign Affairs**

shall have the duties and powers to consider bills, carry out activities, undertake fact-finding or study any matter concerning foreign affairs, international relations, roles and acceptance of Thailand in the international community, overseas Thai people, any situation which may impact the national interest and image, as well as study, monitor, recommend and accelerate National Reform and Master Plans of the National Strategy under the duties and powers and other relevant matters.

**(7) The Committee on Armed Forces and State Security**

shall have the duties and powers to consider bills, carry out activities, undertake fact-finding or study any matter concerning all military affairs, the national

defense industry and development, and relevant matters on comprehensive security as well as study, monitor, recommend and accelerate National Reform and Master Plans of the National Strategy under the duties and powers and other relevant matters.

shall have the duties and powers to consider bills, carry out activities, undertake fact-finding or study any matter concerning the tourism promotion and development, creating the variety and quality tourism, and study the problems and obstacles of the national and international tourism development, as well as study, monitor, recommend and accelerate National Reform and Master Plans of the National Strategy under the duties and powers and other relevant matters.

shall have the duties and powers to consider bills, carry out activities, undertake fact-finding or study any matter concerning the local Administration, the development and promotion for the Efficient administration of local government organizations, decentralization and transfer of missions to the local government organizations in consistence with the entire provincial and national development, including the special local administration, as well as study, monitor, recommend and accelerate National Reform and Master Plans of the National Strategy under the duties and powers and other relevant matters.

shall have the duties and powers to consider bills, carry out activities, undertake fact-finding or study any matter concerning the central and provincial administration, the development of bureaucratic system, town planning and the performance of duties of state officials, as well as study, monitor, recommend and accelerate National Reform and Master Plans of the National Strategy under the duties and powers and other relevant matters.

shall have the duties and powers to consider bills, carry out activities, undertake fact-finding or study any matter concerning the administration, promotion, development, exploration, utilization and conservation of energy, acquisition of renewable energy and alternative energy, studying the impacts and guidelines on resolving the problems and obstacles of exploration and utilization of the energy, energy security, as well as study, monitor, recommend and accelerate National Reform and Master Plans of the National Strategy under the duties and powers and other relevant matters.

shall have the duties and powers to consider bills, carry out activities, undertake fact-finding or study any matter concerning the promotion and encouragement of the political development and other operations to promote the democratic regime of government with the King as Head of State, the public participation in laying down policies, making decision in political issues, planning for economic, social and political development, as well as study, monitor, recommend and accelerate National Reform and Master Plans of the National Strategy under the duties and powers and other relevant matters.

shall have the duties and powers to consider bills, carry out activities, undertake fact-finding or study any matter concerning social development, children, youth, women, the elderly, the disabled and the underprivileged, and coordinate with national and international organizations, national and international communities and local government organizations on directions for cooperation to support problem-solving for society, community, children, youth, women, the elderly, the disabled and the underprivileged, promoting community potentiality in development of living condition, providing protection and care for the poor, promoting equality and eliminating unjust discrimination against a person, promoting and developing social welfare, promoting social power, providing insurance and security and developing quality of life of the Thai citizen as a whole, as well as study, monitor, recommend and accelerate National Reform and Master Plans of the National Strategy under the duties and powers and other relevant matters.

shall have the powers and duties to consider bills, carry out activities, undertake fact-finding or study any matter concerning the implementation of policies on laws, administration of justice, judicial proceedings, police, state attorney and corrections, act in compliance with the law, protect and maintain national peace and order, establish equal access to judicial proceedings, improve for efficient mechanisms and practices in police affairs, as well as study, monitor, recommend and accelerate National Reform and Master Plans of the National Strategy under the duties and powers and other relevant matters.

Shall have the duties and powers to consider bills, carry out activities, undertake fact-finding or study any matter concerning domestic Thai workforce and migrant workers, Thai workforce overseas, freelancers, providing welfare, social security, workplace security, occupational health, promotion and sustainable development of labour potentialities, coordinate with national and international organizations, national and international communities relating to labour, as well as study, monitor, recommend and accelerate National Reform and Master Plans of the National Strategy under the duties and powers and other relevant matters.

Shall have the duties and powers to consider bills, carry out activities, undertake fact-finding or study any matter concerning higher education, academic freedom of higher educational institutions, administration, promotion, support and development of science and technology, research and innovation creation, as well as study, monitor, recommend and accelerate National Reform and Master Plans of the National Strategy under the duties and powers and other relevant matters.

Shall have the duties and powers to consider bills, carry out activities, undertake fact-finding or study any matter concerning information technology, communication, public communication and telecommunication and development of information technology infrastructure, as well as study, monitor, recommend and accelerate National Reform and Master Plans of the National Strategy under the duties and powers and other relevant matters.

Shall have the duties and powers to consider bills, carry out activities, undertake fact-finding or study any matter concerning religions, religion patronization and protection, conservation and inheritance of arts and traditions, local cultures and local wisdom, promotion of moral, virtue, ethics, Thai culture and identity, as well as study, monitor, recommend and accelerate National Reform and Master Plans of the National Strategy under the duties and powers and other relevant matters.

shall have duties and powers to consider bills, carry out activities, undertake fact-finding or study any matter concerning education, educational development of all levels and forms of national education, excluding tertiary education which is not under the duties and powers of the Ministry of Education, providing educational services for the people by considering to the standard, fairness and thoroughness of education, emphasizing intelligent excellence, discipline, moral, ethics, public consciousness, awareness of being Thai on the ground of the democratic regime of government with the King as Head of State, as well as study, monitor, recommend and accelerate National Reform and Master Plans of the National Strategy under the duties and powers and other relevant matters.

shall have duties and powers to consider bills, carry out activities, undertake fact-finding or study any matter concerning public health, health system development, appropriate and standard public health service, including medical treatment, control and prevent of diseases, rehabilitation, health promotion and development of quality of life of the public, and impact of population change and development, as well as study, monitor, recommend and accelerate National Reform and Master Plans of the National Strategy under the duties and powers and other relevant matters.

Master Plans of the National Strategy under the duties and powers and other relevant matters.

shall have duties and powers to consider bills, carry out activities, undertake fact-finding or study any matter concerning the management of land, water resources, forest resources, marine and coastal resources and other natural resources, including the promotion, conservation and protection of quality of environment, eco-friendly development and growth, the study of utilization, protection, modification, conservation of environment, as well as study, monitor, recommend and accelerate National Reform and Master Plans of the National Strategy under the duties and powers and other relevant matters.

shall have duties and powers to consider bills, carry out activities, undertake fact-finding, study and inspect corruption and misconduct in the State agencies or other agencies, strengthening good governance in the administration of state affairs in

accordance with good governance and Sufficiency Economy Philosophy and study any matter concerning mechanisms, procedures and measures to counter corruption and misconduct, as well as study, monitor, recommend and accelerate National Reform and Master Plans of the National Strategy under the duties and powers and other relevant matters.

shall have duties and powers to consider bills, carry out activities, undertake fact-finding or study any matter concerning the promotion, support or development of commerce and industry, protection of intellectual property, development of local and Thai wisdom, social enterprise, community enterprise, Special Economic Zone, competitiveness and growth of eco-friendly industry, as well as study, monitor, recommend and accelerate National Reform and Master Plans of the National Strategy under the duties and powers and other relevant matters.

shall have the duties and powers to consider bills, carry out activities, undertake fact-finding or study any matter concerning the promotion of cooperation and

coordination among government agencies, private organizations and humanitarian organizations, monitor and examine acts of commission or omission which violates human rights, rights and liberties, mass media and public communication, consumer protection and issues that trouble consumers, as well as to study, monitor, recommend and accelerate National Reform and Master Plans of the National Strategy under the duties and powers and other relevant matters.

shall have the duties and powers to consider bills, carry out activities, undertake fact-finding or study any matter concerning budget management, monitoring and evaluation of income and expenses, improving the efficiency and effectiveness of the budget preparation and disbursement in accordance with the National Strategy and other development plans, as well as study, monitor, recommend and accelerate National Reform and Master Plans of the National Strategy under the duties and powers and other relevant matters.

## **The Ad Hoc Committees**

### **(27) The Ad Hoc Committee on the Senate Affairs**

shall have the duties and powers to carry out activities, undertake fact-finding or study any matter as follows:

- (1) to consider a bill or any other matter entrusted by the Senate or the President;
- (2) to follow up the implementation of resolutions and examine the minutes of the sittings;
- (3) to carry out activities or consider any matter which is not the duties and powers of any other committees of the Senate;
- (4) to co-ordinate the Senate with the House of Representatives, the Council of Ministers, the Independent Organs, the State Attorney Organ and other organizations related to the activities of the Senate;
- (5) to co-ordinate with all standing committees and members of the Senate related to the consideration of the name-list of members of the Senate or any person which shall be submitted to the Senate sitting to select as members of the standing committee or members of the ad hoc committee, under Rule 82, Rule 83, Rule 84, Rule 85, Rule 106 or Rule 175, as the case requires, to proceed in an orderly, appropriate and fair manner;
- (6) to provide technical, information, and information technology support to the activities of the Senate;
- (7) to receive complaints or petitions from the public and forward them to various committees or other related organizations for consideration;
- (8) to publicize the work of the Senate;
- (9) to give advice to the Senate relating to the development of work system and the performance of various activities of the Senate;
- (10) to give advice to the Senate relating to preparing the detail of budget and an amendment to the motion of annual appropriations in so far as it is related to the Senate and the Secretariat of the Senate;

(11) to give advice to the Senate relating to providing various welfare and benefits to members of the Senate.

**(28) The Ad Hoc Committee on Protecting and Upholding the Monarchy of the Senate**

shall have the duties and powers to carry out activities, undertake fact-finding and study any matter concerning protecting and upholding the monarchy.

**The Standing Committee in Accordance with Rule 175**

**(29) The Committee on Monitoring, Recommending and Accelerating National Reform and the Preparation and Implementation of the National Strategy**

shall have the duties and powers to monitor, recommend, accelerate, carry out activities, undertake fact-finding or study any matter as follows:

(1) to monitor, recommend and accelerate national reform and the preparation and implementation of the national strategy as a whole in accordance with the Constitution;

(2) to study and analyze the progress report of implementing the national reform plan that the Council of Ministers submitted to the National Assembly under section 270 paragraph one of the Constitution, the summary report of the annual implementation of the national reform plan and national strategy, and the specific report concerning the national reform or national strategy that need to be submitted in accordance with the law;

(3) to gather information and prepare the study report of the progress of implementing the national reform plan that the Council of Ministers reported to the National Assembly every three months in accordance with Section 270 paragraph one of the Constitution in order to submit such study report to the sitting of the Senate within thirty days as from the date the Senate received the aforementioned report;

(4) to gather information and prepare the study report of the annual summary report of implementing the national reform plan and the national strategy that the Office of the National Economic and Social Development Council reported to the Senate in accordance with the law in order to submit such study report to the sitting of the Senate within sixty days as from the date the Senate received the aforementioned report;

(5) to provide a guideline for the benefit of monitoring, recommending and accelerating national reform to achieve the goals in accordance with the Constitution,

and the preparation and implementation of the National Strategy, as well as to coordinate with every Senate Standing Committee to implement the aforementioned guideline and support the aforementioned Committees to integrate working;

(6) to consider a bill to be enacted for the implementation of Chapter 16 National Reform of the Constitution, integrating with related Senate Standing Committees under Rule 78 paragraph two, in advance and report to the President of the Senate to propose such bill to the sitting of the Senate for acknowledgement before consideration through a joint sitting of the National Assembly;

(7) to consider and propose a guideline on electing members of the committee on considering a bill to be enacted for the implementation of Chapter 16 National Reform of the Constitution to the Ad Hoc Committee on the Senate Affairs;

(8) to publicize the result of monitoring, recommending and accelerating national reform and the preparation and implementation of the national strategy;

(9) to establish a system and database on monitoring, recommending and accelerating national reform and the preparation and implementation of the national strategy, operated by the Senate and its committees, as well as connect the information with related agencies and update such information continuously;

(10) to carry out other related activities to achieve the objectives and goals of the national reform and the implementation of the national strategy that have been prescribed in the constitution and laws.
